On August 9, 2012, the Issuer completed a transaction (the "Transaction") whereby it distributed, by means of a dividend, to each holder of its Liberty Interactive common stock (i) 0.05 of a share of the corresponding series of Liberty Ventures common stock for each share of that series of Liberty Interactive common stock held by such holder as of the distribution record date and (ii) 1/3 of a subscription right to purchase one share of Series A Liberty Ventures common stock for each share of Liberty Ventures common stock received by such holder in the distribution. See footnote (2) herein for the continuation of the description of the reported transaction.

In connection with the completion of the Transaction, all equity awards held by the Reporting Person with respect to Series A and Series B Liberty Interactive common stock (each an "Original Interactive Award") were adjusted pursuant to the anti-dilution provisions of the incentive plans under which the equity awards were granted, such that the Reporting Person received (i) an (2) adjustment to the exercise price or base price, as applicable, and number of shares relating to the Original Interactive Award (as so adjusted, an "Adjusted Interactive Award") and (ii) an equity award

- (2) adjustment to the exercise price or base price, as applicable, and number of shares relating to the Original Interactive Award (as so adjusted, an "Adjusted Interactive Award") and (ii) an equity award relating to shares of the corresponding series of Liberty Ventures common stock (a "Ventures Award"). These adjustments were approved by the Issuer's board of directors pursuant to Rule 16b-3 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended.
- (3) The options vest semiannually over four years from the date the options were originally granted.
